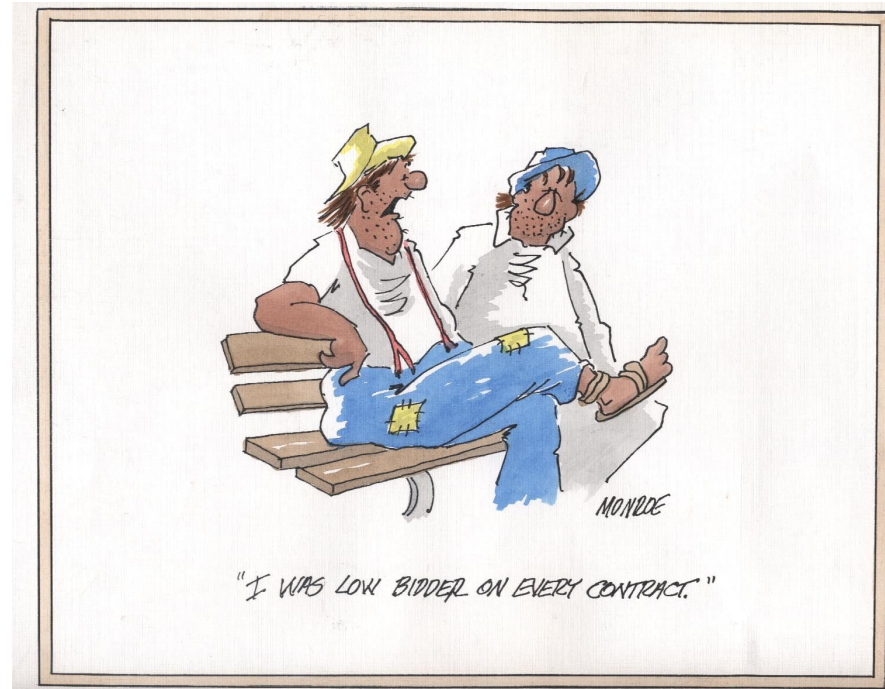

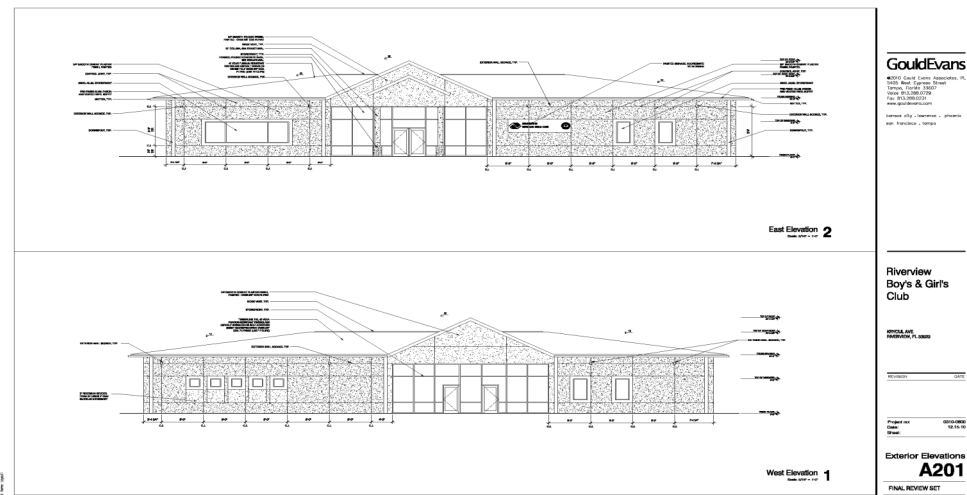

Riverview Boys and Girls Club

Morrick Construction, Inc. has begun new construction of a 6,000 square foot building to house the Riverview Boys & Girls Club on the grounds of Resurrection Catholic Church leased to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Tampa Bay, Inc.

This is a design/build project with Gould Evans Architect and Morrnick Construction and consists of a technology center consisting of 16 computer stations, a main lobby reception area, a training room and a social recreation room.

During the construction of the main building, we will also construct a new covered play court area. This was made possible by recent fundraising activities reaching out to the Riverview community spearheaded by the Boys & Girls Club.



University Community Hospital



Morrick Construction has submitted a design/build proposal to University Community Hospital (UCH) regarding the new front entrance to their main campus (see photo below). We are one of a small select group being considered for this work.

The current workload there is quite active. Under the leadership of Superintendent Wayne Smith, Morrnick has recently completed exterior sitework renovations consisting of new brick pavers, new curb cuts and redesigning traffic patterns. All of these upgrades are designed to give UCH a facelift. We also recently completed a major interior upgrade of the Main Lobby. This consisted of new flooring, new cherry wood paneling and freshly updated signage. Once again, these common area upgrades are really giving the hospital a clean and crisp new look.

On May 1st Morrnick Construction celebrated our 32nd anniversary of incorporation and 29 of those years have been with UCH as a steady partner in the community.
